LISBON ECO MARATHON | April 21st 2024

LISBON ECO MARATHON

These rules establish the rights, obligations and responsibilities of all parties involved in the preparation, Organization, participation and implementation of the Sports Competition.

PART I – OF THE ORGANIZATION

1. ORGANIZATION

The sports competition **Lisbon Eco Marathon** (henceforth referred to as “**Race**”) is organised by the following entities:

Stream Plan, LDA.”, legal subject and with registration number 513381619, registered at Conservatória do Registo Comercial de Lisboa, with its head office at Avenida Engenheiro Duarte Pacheco, n.º 19, 6.º Dto, in Lisbon,

In cooperation with the following entities:

Clube Desportivo e Recreativo Chronos, legal subject number 514798998, registered at Conservatória do Registo Comercial de Lisboa, with its head office at AV. Engº Duarte Pacheco nr 19 – 6º Dto, in Lisbon,

The entities mentioned above organise the Race that is contested exclusively and mandatorily by the participants that are duly registered and accepted, and in the terms presented in these Rules.

Henceforth referred to as “**Organization**”.

2. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

Participation is open to all interested parties, regardless of nationality or gender, as long as they are properly registered in accordance with these rules.

Minimum age of participation for the distances of 42 km and 21 km: participants who have turned 18 by the date of the event.

Minimum age of participation for distances of 12 km: participants who have turned 14 by the date of the event.

Participants that are minors must show and hand to the Organization on the day of picking up the kit, a declaration of responsibility from the person with parental responsibility.

There is no minimum age for participation in the Caminhada ReWalk; children must be accompanied by a responsible adult, and on the day of picking up the kit they will have to present a declaration written and signed by the person with parental responsibility, authorizing their participation.

The Organization's responsibility in terms of insurance will be over the moment the event's official timekeeping is ended. (See point "4 Insurance" in these rules).

Participating with auxiliary means of locomotion will not be allowed, namely bicycle, skateboard, wheelchair, with animals or prams.

It is also prohibited to accompany participants on the course with any type of vehicle, whether motorised or not.

At registration, participants, or their legal tutors or the person with parental responsibility declare, under their responsibility, that they meet the necessary health conditions to participate in the event and that they will abstain from participation if such conditions change.

The participants must possess the necessary health condition for physical activity. At registration, the participants accept that they feel physically and psychologically prepared for the inherent effort required by the sports event they will be taking part in, and thus the Organization cannot be held accountable for any accidents, incidents, illnesses and other situations that may occur before, during and after the participation in the sports competition.

The participants/athletes that fulfil the conditions presented in these Rules may take part in the Race.

3. REGISTRATIONS:

Registrations will be accepted at the secretariat on 20 April. These registrations will be subject to a surcharge of 20€ on the above prices for the last phase, subject to available places.

PREMIUM REGISTRATION - For an additional €19,00 and only until April 2nd, 2021

For an additional fee of 25,00€ and only until February 29nd 2024, the athletes have the possibility of selecting the "Premium" option, which will entitle them to the following services:^[1]_[SEP]

- Race bibs sent by courier (for this to happen, an address must be provided, where the parcel may be delivered in person);
- Lunch;
- VIP Massage.

Registrations are opened and will be closed on the dates that, for each edition, are presented on the site that should be consulted.

4. DATE/TIME

The Lisbon Eco Marathon will take place on Sunday, 21st April 2024.

The start and finish will be at Alameda Cardeal Cerejeira, Parque Eduardo VII.

4.1 - TIME LIMIT

The Lisbon Eco Marathon is an event that integrates four single stage distances, which will have a maximum duration of 6 hours, therefore, considering the starting time of the Marathon distance 42km, the finish line will close at 14h30. After this time, car circulation will be re-established on the whole course.

The time barrier is calculated to allow runners to reach the finish line in the imposed time limit, taking into account possible stops [resting, refuelling, etc.].

For reasons of force majeure [weather and/or safety], the organisation reserves the right to change the time barrier.

5 – OFFICIAL KIT (PARTICIPATION KIT):

MARATHON, HALF MARATHON AND MINI MARATHON

The athlete's participation kit is composed by a t-shirt with allusive lettering to the race, a tyvek paper dorsal, with a non detachable chip and a cloakroom tag.

The available sizes for the t-shirt are the following: S, M, L XL and XXL. The sizes will be distributed according to the requests made at the time of registration.

The participation kits will be picked up during April 20th, between 10am and 7pm, in a tent identified for that purpose, placed near the National Flag, at Alameda Cardeal Cerejeira (Alto do Parque Eduardo VII). There will be no delivery of participation kits outside the date stipulated for the effect.

5.1. PLACEMENT OF DORSAL /CHIP

The use of the official race dorsal and chip is compulsory for all participants.

The dorsal must be permanently visible during the entire race, i.e. it must be positioned on the clothing, chest area, abdomen or on the front of the thigh, and cannot be, for any reason, fixed on the back.

The dorsal and the chip are coded for each participant, being its use personal and non-transferable.

The name and any possible logo of the sponsors cannot be modified or hidden.

Only the participants with visible dorsal will have access to the control/ refuelling stations.

The organisation is not responsible for failure to present results resulting from negligent handling, misplacement and/or deterioration of the chip.

The luggage tag must be placed, visibly, on the bag/backpack.

WALK

The athlete's standard participation kit is composed by a race allusive t-shirt and a wristband that will give access to the cloakroom.

T-shirt sizes: S, M, L, XL and XXL.

The participation kits will be picked up during the day May 6, between 10am and 7pm, in a tent identified for that purpose, placed near the National Flag, at Alameda Cardeal Cerejeira (Alto do Parque Eduardo VII). There will be no delivery of participation kits outside the date stipulated for the effect.

5.2 - CORPORATE PACK

Pack 1: From 10 to 20 inscriptions

Includes:

- Personalised T-shirt (with the company's image and the athlete's name printed on the back).
- 2 accesses per participant to the final lunch.
- Sports massage after the race
- Space dedicated to the team with a 9 m2 tent.

Pack 2: From 20 to 40 registrations

Includes:

- Personalised T-shirt (with company image and athlete's name printed on the back).
- 2 accesses per participant to the final lunch.
- Sports massage after the race.
- Space dedicated to the team with a 9m2 tent
- Concierge service with a person from the organization dedicated to the company's guests, from their arrival until the end of the event.

Pack 3 - Personalised

Should there be any request for a customised pack, we will be pleased to analyse the proposal and execute it, should it be feasible.

6. OFFICIAL EQUIPMENT

The Organization suggests the use of the equipment approved for the current edition of the Event, in accordance with the present Regulations.

The organization approves for the Event, a standard equipment model with the official sponsors, commercial partners and competition suppliers, which will be collected by the participants during April 20th, between 10am and 7pm, in a tent identified for the effect, placed near the National Flag at Alameda Cardeal Cerejeira (Alto do Parque Eduardo VII).

7. SECURITY AND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The organization provides medical support to all participating athletes, with ambulances available in the premises along the route and at the start / finish.

If ensuing medical care is necessary, this will be provided at the public health services, under their responsibility.

The organization, in cooperation with police entities, will condition traffic during the race. However, it cannot be held accountable for any accidents or damages incurred among participants or caused by third parties to participants.

8. RULES OF GOOD CONDUCT

The participants commit themselves on honour to respect the following rules, which they declare to know, accept and respect:

1. Respect the technical regulation of the Event;
 2. Respect the general regulation of the Event and of the organization;
- Respect the rules and recommendations of the Organization;
1. Respect the timetables and the particular prescriptions of each Event, foreseen by the Organizer of each Event.
 2. Respect the correct use of their equipment
 3. Respect the organisation's representatives.
- Respect the sportive spirit of the race and of their opponents.

All the participants commit themselves to an exemplary public behaviour during the race, which cannot, in any way, put at risk the good name and reputation of the organization and its partners, sponsors and other participants.

9. PROHIBITION OF DOPING

Dopping is forbidden from all sports participants within and outside the Race.

Each participant has the duty of ensuring that they do not introduce, or that it is not introduced, any forbidden substance, or that they do not use any forbidden method.

The participants are personally accountable for any forbidden substance or its metabolites or markers found in their organic samples, as well as the use of any forbidden method.

10. DISQUALIFICATION OF PARTICIPANTS

The organization will not allow participation/disqualify from the race any Participant that has any of the following behaviours:

1. Forge any element in their registration;
2. Is not present at the start, at the required time and place;
3. Does not respect instructions from the organization;
4. Does not meet the required physical and psychological conditions to participate;
5. Does not have a bib;
6. Does not have the bib, well visible, in the front of their t-shirt, in the places specified by the organization;
7. Wears another athlete's bib;
8. Folds or manipulates the ads on the bib;
9. Uses the provided bib in a wrongful manner;
10. Does not follow the signage placed by the Organization and jumps the railing to the start;
11. Does not cover the established course in its entirety;
12. Shows clearly unsportsmanlike behaviour (for example: pushing or impeding other athletes in order to intentionally hinder their progression)
13. Doping;
14. Does not respect the other participants, the Organization itself, and the security agents, and other race support parties.

11. ECORESPONSIBILITY

The Participants are required to behave in a responsible manner in what concerns the cleanliness and protection of the environment in every area used during the event, including the race course, the starting point and the finishing line. Littering is expressly prohibited during and after the Race. When applicable, it is the Participants' responsibility to keep any rubbish derived from the food and beverages distributed during the Race. Rubbish bins provided by the Organisation, will be placed along the race course and at the finishing line. Failure to abide by these rules will result in the immediate exclusion of the Participant, as well as exclusion from participating in any other events organised by the same Organisation.

12. COURSES

The courses of the three distances will be through the Monsanto Forest Park with start and finish in Alameda Cardeal Cerejeira - Parque Eduardo VII).

The walk of about 8 km will be between Parque Eduardo VII and Parque Florestal de Monsanto starting and finishing in the same place of the distances above mentioned.

12.1 - METHODOLOGY FOR TIME CONTROL

It will be used an electronic system of time control through reading mats and chip.

The reading of the chip will only occur if it is securely placed in the shoe, without creasing it.

The organization is not responsible for the failure of presentation of results resulting from negligent handling, misplacement and/or deterioration of the chip.

13. SUPPLIES

No non-reusable packaging may be carried.

Any participant who throws any packaging or other product on the ground will be automatically disqualified.

The organisation will make available the following refuelling points.

Marathon (42 Km)

Km 7 | Km 11,5 | Km 16 | Km 19,5 | Km 24 | Km 29 | Km 36 | Finish Line.

Half Marathon (21 km):

Km 5 | Km 10 | Km 15 | Meta.

Mini Marathon (12 Km):

Km 6,5 | Meta.

Walk (8 km):

Km 4 | Meta.

14. CATEGORIES

Classifications will be awarded in the following categories:

The Lisbon Eco Marathon will be open to all athletes whose age, on the date of the race, is in the following brackets:

* The minimum participation age for the 42 km and 21 km distances of the Lisbon Eco Marathon is, in both genders, 18 years old (Juniors), being included in the "Seniors" category.

* The minimum age for the 12 km Lisbon Eco Marathon is, in both genders, 14 years old (Juniors), being included in the "Seniors" category.

All athletes who are minors at the date of the event, must be accompanied by a term of responsibility signed by their parent/guardian.

Whenever requested by the organization, the athletes must present an identification document (ID card or other official document), under penalty of not being awarded the respective prize(s).

15. PAYMENT METHODS

The Payment Methods available for registrants residing in Portugal are

ATM AND MB WAY

The payment methods have a deadline of 48 hours, after that the enrolled has to ask again for new payment data.

The athletes that live outside Portugal, will be able to make the payment through Paypal or credit card.

15.1 ALTERATIONS

1. a) The alteration of data between athletes requires an additional fee of 5 euros.

1. b) Requests for changing distances within the Lisbon Eco Marathon programme (42km, 21km and 12km) will be accepted until 23h59 of March 31st. If the desired distance has a higher value than the registration previously made, the participant will be asked to pay the difference between the registration price at the date of this request and the value paid.

Until the registration deadline, the participant is allowed to change his registration between races, whenever there are places available.

15.2 CONDITIONS FOR THE REFUND OF THE REGISTRATION FEE

The refund can be requested only and exclusively when a participant has a proven impediment to do the race, provided that it is associated with an accident or illness diagnosed after registration in the race.

The cancellation must be requested by e-mail to lisbonecomarathon@clubechronos.com. A medical certificate must be attached to this request.

Cancellations by telephone will not be accepted.

The amount reimbursed is only 50% of the amount paid, and these exceptional requests will be accepted until April 10 for all registrations made within the regular deadlines, date after which there will be no refund.

16. CLOSING OF REGISTRATIONS

The on-line entries will close on 19 April 2024 at 20h00m.

The organization may, at any time, suspend or extend the deadlines, or even add or limit the number of entries in the race according to technical/structural needs/availability, without prior notice.

Registrations will be accepted on the 20th of April at the secretariat. These inscriptions will have an increase of 20€ on the above mentioned prices of the last phase, subject to existing vacancies.

17. INSURANCE

Participants must meet the health conditions necessary for the practice of sports. After registering, they assume they feel physically and psychologically prepared for the physical effort inherent to the event in which they will participate.

All participants, without exception, must meet the health conditions necessary for the practice of sports, exempting the organisation of the event, its partners, supporters and public bodies involved of any responsibility.

The race organisation will provide all those enrolled with personal accident insurance.

All participating athletes, registered in accordance with the procedure described in these regulations, benefit from insurance coverage for personal accidents occurring during the event.

This insurance has an excess of 60 euros, which is the responsibility of the injured party.

The responsibility of the organisation in terms of insurance ends at the moment when the official timing of the event is closed.

18. CLASSIFICATIONS

Within 24 hours after the end of the event, the classification by class will be published. These classifications will only serve to position the athletes within their class, according to the time achieved, and will not be used to award prizes.

For the effect of the classification by class, the chip time will be counted, i.e., the time that the athlete takes from the moment he crosses the starting line until the moment he reaches the finish line.

The classification for prize giving purposes will be based on the order of arrival of the first male and female athletes, regardless of their starting time.

18.1 Deadline for classifications complaints

Any and all complaints must be submitted in writing to the Chairman of the Jury, together with a deposit of x50,00 [non-refundable, should the complaint be rejected] within 2 hours after the arrival of the participant in question. The complaint must contain the name of the complainant, ID/CC or passport number, name of the participant(s) affected, bib number and reasons alleged.

The provisional classifications may also be subject to complaint, up to 15 minutes after their publication.

The competition Jury, which will analyse the complaint, is composed of the President of the Jury, the Race Director, and one or more representatives of the entities responsible for the organisation of the event with a total of 5 elements.

The Jury will give its opinion before the official results are posted.

The participants still have a period of one week to present corrections to the classifications.

19. AWARDS

All participants in the distances with competitive character that finish them will receive an exclusive medal of the event, and will be able to download the participation diploma in the official website of the event.

Awards will be given to the first 3 male and female runners of the three races in a protocol ceremony, as well as to the Biggest Group (Clubs and Companies).

The prizes will be delivered at the official prize giving ceremony. The presence at the ceremony is a moment created to praise the winners and partners who make the realisation of the event possible, therefore there will be no prize giving after the event.

20. EQUIPMENT COLLECTION

The organization provides temporary storage of the "belongings" of the athletes of the 3 distances, in the race secretariat area, and the athletes must ensure the proper packing and closing of the same, in order to avoid the loss of objects and/or values, for which the organization is not responsible.

The organisation is not responsible for the loss, theft or deterioration of the participants' belongings.

21. POSTPONEMENT OR CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT

Several reasons may force the organization to suspend, postpone or cancel the race, as well as to make changes in the places, times or course. In any of these situations it will not be considered a breach of contract, and no responsibility can be demanded from the organisation and it will

not have the obligation to compensate, economically or in any other way, any athlete or any other person or entity for this fact.

22. DATA PROTECTION

The organisation of the Lisbon Eco Marathon fully respects the data protection law, currently in force. The athletes assume the knowledge and authorize the introduction and treatment of their personal data in the files of the race organisation, for its use in the development, administrative and commercial management and other activities. The athletes must indicate the name they wish to see inscribed on the dorsal, entry lists and final classification that will be published on the event's website. The privacy policy allows, however, that any athlete may request the alteration or removal of his/her data, through a request made by e-mail to: lisbonecomarathon@clubechronos.com

By confirming his/her registration, the participant authorizes to be contacted by Stop&Go, Stream Plan and Clube Desportivo e Recreativo Chronos via phone, sms and email with the following purposes

- information of payment data
- participant data information
- classification information
- Information about the event

Additionally, if the participant gives his authorisation when he registers, he authorises the Organisation to

- Treat the personal data received by the Organisation or generated as a consequence of registration in the Race, to carry out commercial actions of a general nature or adapted to their profile, by any means (Letter, telephone, email, SMS, MMS, instant messaging applications, etc.) about products or services of the Organisation and the companies belonging to the Podium Events, S.A. group of companies or related to the realisation and organisation of events, races and sporting competitions, merchandising or similar activities, for the period of time provided by the Organisation in its internal data conservation policies. The Participant may revoke this authorisation at any time.

The Participant may at any time exercise their rights of access, rectification, cancellation/deletion, opposition, limitation and portability as recognised under current legislation on the protection of personal data, by writing to the Organisation by registered post with acknowledgement of receipt to the address Avenida Engenheiro Duarte Pacheco, n.º 19, 6, Dto, 1070-100 Lisbon or by email to lisbonecomarathon@clubechronos.com

Without prejudice to the Participant being able to exercise the rights previously indicated, the Organisation will retain the personal data provided by the Participant and generated as a result of registration and/or participation in the sporting event, for the duration of the event, as well as during the limitation period for any legal action that either party may bring.

After the aforementioned period, the Organisation may keep the personal data processed in order to identify former participants to be able to offer them discounts and promotional

campaigns in future events, as well as to be able to provide them with products and services of the Organisation, whenever they have previously authorised this.

For a better understanding of the data protection measures implemented by the Organisation, participants should consult the terms of the Privacy Policy published on the event's official website at lisbonecomarathon.com

23. IMAGE RIGHTS

The enrolment in the race and the consequent acceptance of these regulations necessarily implies the participant's authorisation for the organisation to make a total or partial recording of his participation, being able to use these images freely for the disclosure and promotion of the race in all media (television, radio, press, internet, posters, cards and flyers, photos and videos). He/she therefore cedes all the image rights regarding the commercial and advertising exploitation of those recordings, without the right to receive any economic compensation from the organisation.

24. COMMERCIAL AND ADVERTISING RIGHTS

The Organisation holds, exclusively, the publicity and commercial rights of the Event, being responsible for negotiating and administering such rights on behalf and in the interest of all the participants, sponsors, partners and other entities.

The Organisation has the exclusive right to receive, retain and distribute all the revenue derived from the exploitation of the commercial and advertising rights.

All contracts or commercial agreements relating to the commercial exploitation of the Event must be scrupulously respected by the participants. Participants must make every effort to ensure compliance with the obligations undertaken in this respect by the Organisation.

Unless expressly authorized by the Organization, it is expressly forbidden to the participant, during the period of the Event, to display advertising in any form, and the promotion of companies, products, goods, equipment or services.

Participants shall be responsible for any costs arising from the use, during and after the Event, of registered brands, patents or intellectual property rights licences.

Should the Organisation be sued for having infringed any of the rights mentioned in the previous point, the Participant is obliged to compensate the Organisation for all the expenses it may have to incur as a result and for all the amounts it may have to pay under any circumstances.

25. JURY

The organisation will constitute a Race Jury, composed by five elements from the organisation that will decide on penalties to apply and on all matters related to the race that have not been subject to regulation or on misinterpretations of these regulations.

26. SUBSEQUENT SUBMISSIONS

In case an enrolled athlete does not take part in the event, nor collects his/her documents and eventual gifts at the event secretariat, no remittance will be made of this material that can only be collected on site on the dates of the event.

27. COMPLAINTS

Any complaints must be submitted in writing to the organization, at the event location or after the race, to the e-mail: lisbonecomarathon@clubechronos.com

28. OTHER

The organization is not responsible for any loss or damage that may affect the participants' equipment. The participant releases the organisation from any responsibility for any loss or deterioration of personal belongings, under any circumstances.

By registering and validating the Lisbon Eco Marathon, the participants assume the knowledge and unreserved acceptance of the regulations, renouncing any legal action against the organisation, derived from their participation in the event.

These regulations may be altered. Any alterations, additions or introduction of eventual annexes to these regulations will be published on the official website of the event, which will be tacitly accepted, if within a maximum of eight days from the date of publication they do not oppose any of the rules introduced, provided that they do so in writing to the organisation by emailing lisbonecomarathon@clubechronosm.com.

The organization will constitute a Race Jury, composed by five elements of the organization that will decide on the sanctions to apply and on all matters related to the race that have not been object of regulation or on misinterpretations of the present regulation.

In case an enrolled athlete does not take part in the race, nor collects his/her documentation and eventual gifts at the event secretariat, this material will not be sent and can only be collected on site on the dates of the event.

This regulation will be in force after 8pm on 21/07/2023, revoking all previous provisions or determinations.

29. ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS OF RESPONSIBILITY

By registering, all participants accept the present regulation and, in case of doubt or in the appearance of a situation not contemplated in it, they must immediately inform the organisation and expose their doubts in writing.

By clicking on the box, you are confirming that you agree with the conditions and rules for registration and participation in the Event and all the conditions foreseen in these Regulations, which is equivalent to declare the following

1. I have read and agree with the regulation of the OFFICIAL LISBON ECO MARATHON SPORT EVENT, available on the website lisbonecomarathon.com
2. I am conscious of my health condition and I confirm that I have all the physical and psychological conditions to participate in the Event
3. I assume that I will not take part in the Event if my health condition changes after the registration
4. I am aware of the contents of the insurance policy in force
5. By participating in the Event, I freely and unconditionally authorise the Organisation and the partners of the Event to use my image. As such, I waive all rights to the use of my image, namely in photographs and filming that will take place during the competition, renouncing the receipt of any amount that may be received with its divulgation in support media
6. I take part in the Event of free will, exempting the Organisation, partners, directors, collaborators and other companies connected to the organisation of the Event of any responsibility resulting from my participation, before, during and after the Event (as for example, loss of personal belongings by theft, damage, or by other circumstances)
