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IMPORTANT INFO

- * By registering, you agree in full to these regulations.
- * You need to be in the right physical condition for the characteristics of this extremely tough race, which combines mileage, duration, mountainous terrain, steep gradients, exposure to unfavorable weather conditions, etc.
- * Vouga Trail stands for ethics and essential values: solidarity and respect for and towards the organization, the runners, volunteers, sponsors, partners, athletes' families and the public, allied to healthy sporting practice.
- * It is essential to drink at every aid stations and to eat regularly.
- * Registration is personal and non-transferable and is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- * The veracity of the data provided is the responsibility of the participant, including for insurance purposes
- * In case that participant is unable to take part and/or the weather conditions do not allow the event to take place or even it is cancelled, the organization is not obliged to return the registration fees or refund the participant.
- * Changes to the data provided by participants after **January 1, 2027** will not be accepted.
- * Given the imperative need to preserve a natural heritage of enormous wealth, we want you to enjoy it in full communion with nature, respecting and protecting it. For this very reason, we would like to inform you that liquid refreshments will not be supplied in bottles or plastic cups. Each athlete is responsible for bringing with them the container(s) they deem most suitable for their hydration (preferably also for hot drinks).
- * The organization reserves the right to accept last-minute registrations.
- * This regulation is subject to change.

1. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

1.1 AGE PARTICIPATION IN THE DIFFERENT RACES

The competitive races in the Vouga Trail event are only for athletes aged 18 or over, with the exception of Vouga Trail Mini for athletes aged 16 or over, Vouga Trail Walk for athletes aged 14 or over and Vouga Kids for athletes aged 4 or over, with parental permission, by completing and signing the attached liability form - REQUIRED CONDITION. The disclaimer must be sent to the organization's email address or handed in when picking up the bib. The email address to be used is: geral@vougatrail.pt.

1.2 REGULARIZED REGISTRATION

In order to take part in the race, the athlete must have previously registered by the established deadlines and accept all the rules set out in these regulations.

1.3 PHYSICAL CONDITIONS

To take part, it is essential to:

- Be aware of the specific distances and difficulties of trail running and their unevenness, as well as being adequately prepared physically and mentally;
- Having acquired, before the event, a capacity for mountain autonomy that allows them to manage the problems that arise in this type of race, namely;
- Being able to cope without outside help with adverse environmental and weather conditions (wind, heat, cold, fog and rain);
- Being able to manage physical or mental problems resulting from extreme fatigue, digestive problems, muscle and joint pain, minor injuries, etc.

1.4 DEFINING THE POSSIBILITY OF EXTERNAL HELP

Support for athletes from outside the organization is only permitted at the aid stations. The athlete, in accordance with point 1.3, must be aware of their needs during the race, as well as their ability to solve problems in the event of unexpected situations.

1.5 BIB PLACEMENT

The bib is personal and non-transferable. The athlete's bib must be in a place that is easily visible to the organizers and other entities that support and/or collaborate with the race. In the event of withdrawal, the athlete must hand in the bib to the organizers at the race office, thereby communicating their withdrawal. Afterwards, the bib can be collected as a souvenir from the race director's office at the event venue.

1.6 RULES OF SPORTS CONDUCT

Inappropriate behavior, such as using offensive language, verbal or physical aggression or leaving litter on the tracks, will not be tolerated and will lead to disqualification.

2. RACE

2.1 RACE PRESENTATION / ORGANIZATION

On January 8, 9 and 10, 2027, the AZtrail Association, in partnership with the Municipality of Sever do Vouga, will organize the **eighth edition** of the Vouga Trail, divided into the following events: Vouga Trail Ultra, Vouga Trail Long, Vouga Trail Short, Vouga Trail Mini, UPHILL Vouga, Vouga Walk, and Vouga Kids. There will also be the Vouga Trail Green Stages, which will allow athletes to take part in a 3-stage race, with a total distance of approximately 65km (5km, 38km, and 22km) over 3 consecutive days.

Starting and ending in the center of Sever do Vouga, at the Sever do Vouga Sports Pavilion (EN 328), at Av. Comendador Augusto Martins Pereira, 3740 Sever do Vouga, it will be a circular race covering distances of 55 km, 35 km, 22 km, 14 km, and a 12 km walk. UPHILL Vouga will start in Sra Dolorosa, Ribeiradio, and end at Baloço Serra e Mar, Ladário. In the Vouga Kids event, the distances will be adjusted to the age groups of the participants, with a minimum length of 500 meters and a maximum length of 2000 meters.

On January 8, UPHILL Vouga will take place.

On January 9, Vouga Trail Ultra, Vouga Trail Longo, and Vouga Kids will take place.

On January 10, Vouga Trail Curto, Vouga Trail Mini, and Caminhada Vouga will take place.

Participants in the Vouga Trail will have the opportunity to run in the natural heritage area of the municipality of Sever de Vouga, along inhospitable, verdant trails, levadas, the banks of the Vouga River, and Mirador do Castelo, located between the Serra da Freita, Arestal, and Ladário mountain ranges.

Simultaneously with the competitive events (trail), there will be a medium-difficulty, non-competitive walk. On the second day of the competitive events, there will be a social event, Vouga Kids. At the end of their events, all participants will be entitled to showers. **Locations to be announced in the athlete's guide.**

2.4 MAP / ALTIMETRIC PROFILE

(Altimetry data will be available in the Athlete's Guide, to all registered athletes, as well as on the Vouga Trail digital channels).

2.5 LIMIT TIME

Any participant in any of the events who withdraws must notify the organization of their withdrawal, providing their race number.

The time limit for completing the Vouga Trail Ultra event will be 12:30 p.m.

The time limit for completing the Vouga Trail Long event will be 8:00 a.m.

The time limit for completing the UPPHILL Vouga event will be 1:30 a.m.

The time limit for completing the Vouga Trail Short and Vouga Trail Mini events will be 5:00 a.m. and 4:00 a.m., respectively.

There will be time barriers at locations defined by the organization, with a view to the safety of participants in the event. The time barriers can be consulted on the altimetry maps. The time barriers are subject to change.

2.6 TIME SYSTEM

Control carried out using a chip that athletes must validate at each checkpoint. Failure to return and/or loss of a chip to the organization is the sole responsibility of the participant. Participants will be responsible for all costs associated with its replacement.

Only staff members will touch the containers with the food and drinks provided. Athletes should not touch the containers and should only indicate what they want.

2.9.1 MATERIAL CHECK

There will be a material check at the zero control, at which the athlete will be subject to disqualification if they fail to comply with the mandatory material.

2.10 INFORMATION ON PASSING POINTS WITH ROAD TRAFFIC

The organization will have a safety system in place along the entire route. however, given that it will be impossible to close some roads to traffic, participants must comply with traffic rules on public roads and respect the environment along the route, bearing in mind that the route may cross private property, under penalty of having to assume potential damages and compensation resulting from non-compliance.

2.11 PENALTIES / DISQUALIFICATIONS

The athlete is penalized:

- 60min for lack of compulsory material at the checkpoints.

The athlete is disqualified:

- If they arrive at the intermediate checkpoint after the time set by the organization.
- If they arrive at the finish line control after the closing time.
- If they do not follow the stipulated route.
- If you don't follow the instructions of the organizers.
- Any unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Any polluting behavior.

In future editions, the organization will prevent the registration of athletes and pedestrians who display bad conduct during the event.

2.12 RESPONSIBILITIES TOWARDS THE ATHLETE/PARTICIPANT

Registration for the race implies full acceptance of these regulations. Participants will be held responsible for all actions likely to cause material, moral or other damage to themselves and/or third parties. The organization declines all responsibility in the event of an accident, negligence or theft of objects and/or valuables from each participant. The organization, as well as any of those involved in organizing the race, are exempt from any liability resulting from the acts described above.

2.13 SPORTS INSURANCE

The organization contracts the insurance required by law for this type of event. The insurance premium is included in the registration fee.

Payment of the insurance deductible in the event of an accident is the sole responsibility of the athletes.

Any accident or incident that occurs during the course of the race is the responsibility of the participants for anything that exceeds the risk covered by the insurance.

The organization will not assume any expenses for claims of which it was not notified in a timely manner to activate the insurance.

To activate the insurance, and in case it is not activated during the race, the athlete and/or organization must use the email geral@vougatrail.pt. **The maximum time for activation will be 24 hours after the conclusion of the event.**

3. REGISTRATIONS

3.1 REGISTRATION PROCESS (SITE, WEB PAGE)

Entries will be made via the Stop and Go platform in accordance with the rules issued there.

Registration is a condition of the athlete's acceptance of these participation rules. The bib will be picked up individually and identification will be required.

3.2 ELITE ATHLETES

The organization reserves free and discounted spots for elite athletes. The criteria for distinguishing an elite runner is their ITRA performance index (Men ≥ 825 / Women ≥ 700), or having been a winner in one of the previous editions of the Vouga Trail. Any request to obtain an elite athlete registration must be submitted by email to geral@vougatrail.pt.

THE REQUEST MUST ALWAYS BE MADE BEFORE THE ATHLETE VALIDATES THEIR REGISTRATION. REQUESTS ARE ALWAYS SUBJECT TO REVIEW BY THE RACE DIRECTOR.

As Vouga Kids is a social event, registration is free but mandatory. To participate, children must have a signed liability waiver from their parent or guardian, provided by the organization – MANDATORY REQUIREMENT.

In order to promote and motivate young people to participate in sports, no timing or classification system will be used.

3.4 REFUND OF REGISTRATION FEE

The organization is not obligated to refund the registration fees of athletes who have already confirmed their participation but are unable to attend on the day of the event. If an athlete requests to change their registration to a shorter distance race, any difference in price will not be refunded.

3.5 RACE OFFICE/TIMES AND LOCATIONS

The race office will be open on the following days and at the following times:

- January 8: 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- January 9: 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- January 10: 7:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

All athletes must bring identification and four pins.

As the Athlete Kit contains an item that is mandatory for the race, the race number, it can only be collected and handed over to the athlete themselves. Kits cannot be delivered after the official closing of the secretariat. There is no option to have race numbers sent to your home address.

3.6 NON-TRANSFERABILITY OF REGISTRATION

Registration for the Vouga Trail is non-transferable, rendering it irregular and consequently invalid and not covered by insurance.

Any change of details or user of the registration/bib number must be communicated to the organization, which will assess the feasibility of the possible change and

subsequently inform the participant of the decision taken. The transfer of registration has an **administrative cost of €5.00**. Within 5 days, the organization will contact the participant in order to expedite the process. If there is no confirmation of the change by the race organization, it shall not be considered.

The deadline for exchanging registration data is January 1, 2027.

4.4 DEADLINES FOR COMPLAINING CLASSIFICATIONS

Any and all complaints must be submitted in writing and sent to the Race Director, accompanied by a deposit of €50 (non-refundable if the complaint is rejected) within 1 hour of the participant's arrival.

The complaint must include the name of the complainant, ID/CC or passport number, name(s) of the participant(s) affected, bib number, and reasons for the complaint. The Jury will make its decision before the official results are posted.

6. OTHER INFORMATIONS

6.1 MARKING AND CONTROLS

The route will be marked with brightly colored ribbons and flags, and passing through established controls will be mandatory.

6.2 ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

All athletes are strongly advised not to use any substances, pharmacological groups or methods intended to artificially increase their physical capabilities. In this, as in any Trail Running event, any athlete may be chosen to participate in an anti-doping control, so it is recommended that you carefully read the ATRP Federal Anti-Doping Regulations.

6.3 ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

The athlete is solely responsible for transporting all natural (even biodegradable) or non-natural wrappers and waste, originating from gels, bars and/or others. You must deposit the waste at the nearest gas station, or transport it to the finish line.

6.4 IMAGE RIGHTS

Acceptance of this regulation necessarily implies that the participant authorizes the race organizers to record all or part of their participation in it, it also presupposes their agreement so that the organization can use the athlete's image for the promotion and dissemination of the race in all its forms (radio, written press, video, photography, internet, posters, media, etc.) and assigns all rights to its commercial and advertising exploitation that it deems appropriate to carry out, without the right, on the part of the athlete, to receive any compensation economic.

6.5 DATA PROTECTION

By formalizing their registration, all participants authorize the publication of their personal data necessary for the running of the race, whether in official lists, in the media, or on the internet, as well as its use for sending information related to the event, including subsequent editions. They also authorize the images collected (photographs or videos) to be used indefinitely in any advertising campaign, for the sole purpose of promoting and publicizing the event.

Each participant is responsible for the accuracy of the information provided in their registration.

All participants may exercise their right to access, rectify, or cancel their personal data by sending an email to **geral@vougatrail.pt**. If the participant is a member of the ATRP, the act of registration implies authorization for their data to be transmitted for the purposes of compiling the classification and ranking for the various trophies.

6.6 SUPPORT AND EMERGENCY

There will be support, relief and emergency teams to provide assistance to participants who need it.

6.7 SUSPENSION AND/OR RACE CANCELLATION

The organization may cancel the event whenever it understands that the safety of participants may be at stake.

If weather or environmental conditions are extreme, the start may be delayed by a maximum of two hours, after which the race is cancelled.

They can also be suspended or canceled by decision of official entities such as Civil Protection, GNR, MAI, ICNF, etc.

6.8 OMISSIONS CASES

Any cases not covered by these regulations will be resolved by the organization, whose decision will not be appealed.

The organization reserves the right to modify these regulations up until the date of the event.

6.9 OTHER POINTS

Completing and sending the registration form implies that the athlete who registers is aware of and accepts these regulations without any reservations.

Participants are obliged to help injured parties and respect traffic rules at road intersections.

The organization reserves the right to accept last minute registrations.

The organization reserves the right to make any changes to the program and route that it deems necessary depending on different conditions, as well as to suspend the race if weather conditions so require, or due to force majeure.

The event can also be canceled as long as it is decreed by the Civil Defense, General Directorate of Health or any other higher authority.
